Finding a College Scholarship

1. Start your search early
2. Check your prospective schools
3. Ask academic advisor
4. Search on scholarships.com
5. Be aware of scholarship deadlines

Applying for Financial Aid

- Create a FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov or fafsa.ed.gov
- Look up and enter school codes of your choice in the application. Recommended to put in at least 3 schools
- Use IRS Data retrieval tool
 - This transfers data from the IRS to your FAFSA application

8 Steps to Completing the FAFSA Form

- Create a FSA ID.
- Start the FAFSA form at fafsa.gov.
- Fill out the student demographics section.
- List the schools that will receive your FAFSA information.
- Answer the dependency status questions.
- Fill out the parent demographics section if filing as a dependent student.
- Provide your financial information.
- Sign and submit your FAFSA form.
