- Consider the results of giving in

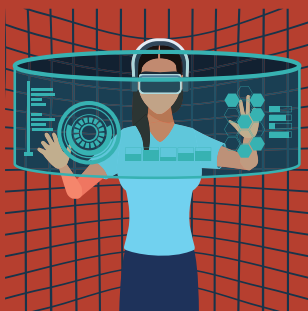
