




FAFSA

While not a November deadline, you should submit the FAFSA as early as possible after it becomes available to be considered for financial aid. Students can now file their 2025–26 FAFSA online at fafsa.gov, as FASFA has been opensince October 1.



Many colleges have deadlines on November 1 or 15 for Early Action or Early Decision applications. Always check the specific deadlines for the colleges you're interested in, as some have their own dates or accept rolling admissions.



SAT/ACT TEST DATES

In 2025, the final <u>SAT test dates</u> are expected to be October 4, November 8, and December 6. The final <u>ACT test dates</u> for this year are September 6, October 18, and December 13. Keep in mind that students will often have to register for these exams a month in advance.
