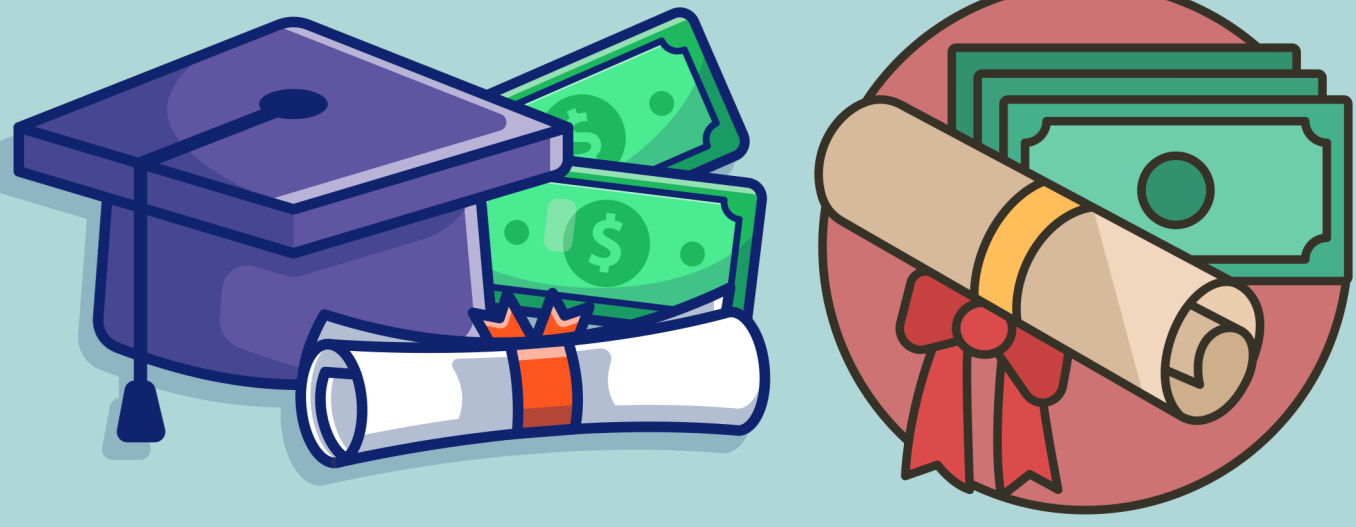

## JUNE SCHOLARSHIP LIST

### Regions Riding Forward® Scholarship Contest

**Deadline: June 30**

- Be a legal U.S. resident of one of the Eligible States.
- Be age 16 or older.
- Have at least one (1) year (or at least 18 semester hours) remaining before your undergraduate college graduation.
- If you are not yet in college, begin your freshman year of college no later than the start of the 2027 – 2028 college academic school year.
- As of your most recent school enrollment period, have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 in school (and if no GPA is provided at school, be in “good standing” or the equivalent thereof in school).

### Hearts for Community Service

**Deadline: June 30**

- Must be a resident of one of the eligible states
- Minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent GED scores accepted)
- Must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a post-secondary institution
- Must demonstrate active involvement in community service

#### Application Process

1. Prepare a minimum 500-word essay addressing the following:
  - Describe how you are of service and the positive impact it has made on your community.
  - Explain how your volunteerism has had an impact on your life.
  - Discuss how this scholarship will assist in furthering your education.
  - Share what the opportunity to receive a post-secondary education means to you.
2. Complete the official application form during the open period (June 1st to June 30th).
3. Provide proof of enrollment or acceptance into a post-secondary institution.
4. Submit a current academic transcript showing a GPA of 2.75 or higher (or GED equivalent).

### Leslie Richardson Memorial Swan & Sparrow Scholarship Fund

**Deadline: June 30**

- Student must have a 3.0 GPA or higher
- Student must have been accepted into an HBCU
- Student must be a high school senior from Washington, D.C.; Virginia; or North Carolina
- Student must be entering his/her freshman year to study musical performance, jazz studies or choral conducting at an accredited HBCU
- Student must submit an audition tape
- Admitted college freshman studying musical performance, jazz studies, or choral conducting at an accredited HBCU in DC, VA, or NC may apply

### Too Cool To Pay For School Scholarship

**Deadline: Quarterly Winner- June 30**

- Open to all current high school, college, and graduate students
- Open to US residents, DACA and undocumented students, and international students currently studying in the US.
- Only one entry allowed per person per quarter. A new winner will be chosen every quarter.
- Scholarships or prizes will be awarded directly to the winners.
- Winners will be notified by e-mail and posted on our website.

### NC Educational Lottery Scholarship

**Deadline: June 30**

- Complete the FAFSA
- Be a North Carolina resident student for tuition purposes
- Enroll for at least six credit hours per semester in a curriculum program
- Meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements of the institution
- Be admitted, enrolled and classified as an undergraduate student in matriculated status in a degree, certificate or diploma program at an eligible North Carolina institution
- Meet requirements for the Federal Pell Grant
- The number of recipients will vary.

- This scholarship is open to current high school students (freshman, sophomores, juniors, and seniors).
- Students can either be living in the US (as a US citizen, permanent resident, or with DACA status) or living internationally, but must be planning to attend a college or university in the US.
- The deadlines for the scholarship are December 31st and June 30th of each year.
- Scholarship amount: \$1,000 per application period
- One winner will be chosen for each application period.
