Must have a 3.0 overall GPA (must provide a copy of their transcript —unofficial transcripts accepted)
Must have one signed letter of recommendation from a leader or director that can attest to their work in the community
Must be a student in Jamaica or the United States

- Recommendations (teachers and guidance counselors), and Financial need.
